


# **Processing instructions – Floor Tiles**

Self-adhesive, Art.-No. 274-XXXX

## **Preparation**


For each design, the batch numbers on the back of the box should be compared with each other at the time of purchase.

- Required tools: Ruler/tape measure, pencil, utility knife
- Acclimatisation: store for 48 hours in the room in which the floor tiles are being laid
- Temperature: room temperature of 20°C-22°C




- Apply the first floor tile.
- First press down the centre of the floor tile, then the edge. Alternatively, you can use an unused paint roller to press down the tiles.
- Apply further floor tiles edge-to-edge without leaving any space between the joins.

### **Surface preparation**




- fill/level any unevenness (> 0.5 mm), holes, cracks, joints (> 3 mm).
- Remove dust, dirt, grease, oil, adhesive residues and wax from the surface.
- Optional: use adhesive primer or double-sided adhesive tape for greater adhesion.




• Cut the floor tiles to size around the edges with a utility knife.

#### Laying



• Remove the backing paper.

### **Cleaning and care**



- Wait for five days before cleaning the floor tiles for the first time.
- Clean floor tiles using a broom or a damp cloth.
- Caution: avoid standing water.
